A Man and a Vision

It was in the late seventies and early eighties that the vision was formed and plans were made to lay the foundation of the International Christian Chamber of Commerce (ICCC). ICCC was registered in Brussels, Belgium in July 1985 as a Non-profit International Association (AISBL).

The aim is to put the Kingdom of God as the first priority in our business lives and to teach and train men and women to respond to the Biblical challenge of a walk with Christ in the Marketplace.

Drawing on insights and wisdom from walking with the Lord in my own business life, coupled with the foundational Word of God, I often speak on "a release under the

Lordship of Christ" showing that through the redemptive work of Jesus, there is indeed a freedom from the drudgery of business to be experienced in our professional and business lives. The door into that freedom is Jesus and is accessed through faith in Him.

There were a series of prophetic confirmations, which led to the initiation of ICCC. The Bible tells us that *we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them*. I experienced the truth of these words; everything was prepared beforehand for the birthing of ICCC.

When looking back on the short history of ICCC, I feel as if I have had to run as fast as I could in front of a big train, so as not to be run over. Today

Message from the President

All of us at some point find ourselves in difficult situations, but let us receive encouragement in learning to be overcomers during those seasons.

Let us be reminded of Paul's words to the believers at Lystra shortly after he had been stoned and dragged out of the city and left for dead. As the believers gathered around his body to begin the mourning process, he rose up and continued to fulfill his ministry responsibilities!

After first visiting the city of Derbe, he felt compelled to go back through Iconium and Antioch to re-visit the believers at Lystra to deliver a prophetic word. After exhorting them not to be discouraged by what they had seen him go through, he explained, "*We must through many tribulations enter the Kingdom of God*". (Acts 14:22).

Make no mistake; Paul was not speaking to them about receiving their salvation. For our salvation is a free gift provided by the

blood of Jesus, which we receive through our faith in His finished work as He endured those hours of passion for us that resulted in His death and resurrection. Rather, Paul was speaking of what Jesus continually referred to in His teaching as the "Kingdom of God" or "The Kingdom of Heaven".

This prophetic word from Paul, like most true prophecy, was direct and to the point telling the people what they needed to hear. The true prophet must not engage himself or herself in simply communicating an encouraging word that conveys only wonderful positive things about people that they want to hear. The responsibility to deliver a true prophetic word is to tell people what they need to hear, not necessarily what they want to hear. God's true prophets want to please God, not men.

Therefore, I would like to pass along a

Following on from last years ICCC International Prayer Conference a new conference was convened 19-23 May in Örebro, Sweden, assembling approximately 1000 delegates.

The conference was arranged in partnership between ICCC Sweden, the church Kristet Centre, Cross Sweden and the Swedish National Prayer network. Among the speakers were Rev. Ed Silvano, USA/Argentina; Rev. Thomas Muthee, Nairobi, Kenya; Dag Wilund, ICCC Pres. Sweden; Jan Stureson, ICCC Vice Pres. Sweden; Fredrik Forslund, ICCC Sweden; and J. Gunnar Olson, Founder and Chairman of ICCC.

"The task is not to get the people into the church, but to get the Kingdom of God into the world", Rev. Ed Silvano said. "We must use the keys of the Kingdom, find the keyhole and unlock the doors, this is how we attack the gates of hell," he said. The whole aim of the conference was summed up through the conference theme; "The Kingdom of God – and the

Transformation of the Society". It was evident that the conference a year ago laid a solid foundation for effective steps to cover the whole nation with prayer.

Today over five hundred "Lighthouses" of prayer have been registered throughout Sweden to intercede for the nation. By now many church leaders are joining the Cross Sweden initiative and approximately ten new "Lighthouses" of prayer are registered every week, and next year in May the Olympic Stadium in Stockholm is booked for a national manifestation in prayer with an expected crowd of over 10.000 intercessors participating.

It has become very evident that the church Kristet Centre, Örebro, has been really challenged through hosting these two conferences. It is going through a revolutionary change in which the church is being challenged to nourish a much wider spectrum of ministry callings.

There are those in political and civic leadership who are now finding a home in the church. This means that the Gospel of the Kingdom is now permeating the city hall and other assemblies of authority in an entirely new way. This is more than the gospel of salvation! As a visible manifestation this conference also featured an excellent exhibition in a special hall of 1.500 square metres featuring the products and services of 33 businesses. Among the featured products was a new electric car, IT-related

products, fine art, electronic products and industrial plastic products. It was in this very stimulating atmosphere several excellent business seminars were also held.

We believe that this exhibition represented a prophetic step toward a much bigger event in the near future, perhaps in conjunction with the national Day of Prayer in Stockholm when we expect some three hundred businesses might be given the opportunity to exhibit their glory. Jesus has come to town – and it was demonstrated in power as people were delivered from bondage into the glorious freedom of the Kingdom! ☐

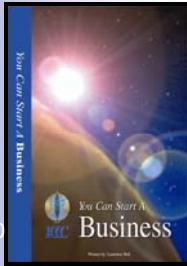

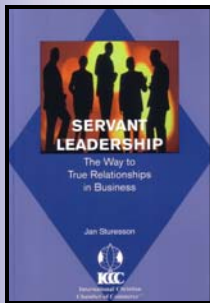

As you endeavor to discern the will of God for your life, a primary scripture you should continually refer to is 1 Thessalonians 4:3, "For this is the will of God for your life; YOUR SANCTIFICATION." A clean vessel will be able to clearly hear God's voice. Character before commission is the Lord's way. Purity always precedes power.

Ambitious, self-willed people seek the opportunities for prominence and promotion. Derek Prince once said before he passed away that in all his decades of ministry he had come to realize that selfish ambition was the most grievous sin among leaders in the body of Christ. "For where envy and self-seeking exists, confusion and every evil thing are there." James 3:16.

I thank God for each of you and pray that your faith and obedience will grow exceedingly. May your love for each other and those you are called to serve in deed and power be released in true wisdom. "But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. The fruit of righteousness is sown in peace, by those who make peace" James 3:17-18.

Please allow me to close this brief word

with an excerpt from the prophecy that God provided at the beginning of ICCC. "This new thing is to be a plantation which is clean and pure. I see great trees and many smaller trees and bushes. The big trees will protect the plantation (not the small trees and bushes), when the storm is breaking loose. Here is neither high nor low... only Jesus. The Lord will use these for many remarkable miracles. The trees and bushes are full of fruit and berries containing great power."

Please allow me to encourage you to realize that as those associated with His Kingdom through ICCC, God wants you to be fruitful. This fruitfulness is to contain great power, regardless of whether you consider yourself to be a tree or a bush. In ICCC, there is to be no high or low, only Jesus. Your responsibility is to step out, be fruitful in your area of influence by taking responsibility without reaching for power. Bring the Kingdom into your Marketplace just as if the Marketplace was in heaven. The Kingdom should not be communicated through you in word only, but in deed and power.

May your joy and peace be full as you increase in your obedience to God's Kingdom principles. □

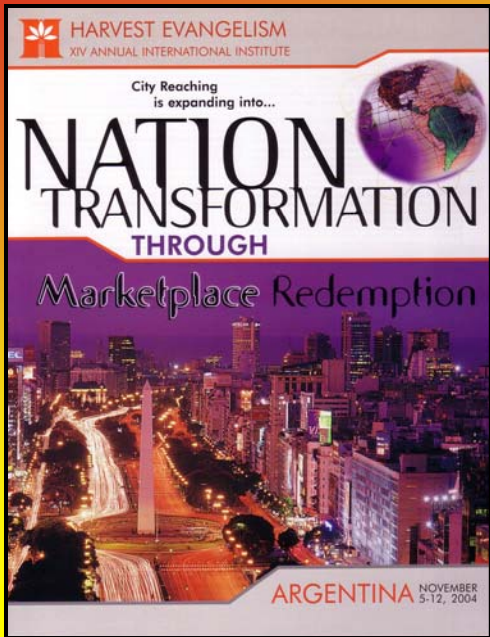
slavery, passing through the desert into the Promised Land. As with the Israelites under Moses, we find that the hardest part of this
